### 1. What's a typical day like for an IBI Group Co-op/Intern?

Consulting is an exciting and fast-paced industry, but it can also be a bit intimidating and overwhelming at first. We support our students in this transition into our work environment by providing training, resources, and mentorship opportunities.

While we do have some roles that are specifically for students who are part of formal co-ops or Internship programs we are open to all applicants. If you are not part of a formal co-op or internship program, the best time to apply is generally for the May term.
